

When Chinese people find out that someone comes from London, they often say, "London is a foggy city, isn't it?" British people who visit China often have to say that London is not a foggy city at all! In fact, London u\_\_86\_\_ to be a foggy city, but it isn't any more.

In London, lots of its pollution came from factories, but a lot of it came from *coal* because people burned it in their houses to keep w\_\_\_87\_\_during the winter. By the 1950s, London's air pollution had become so bad that the government decided to do something to clean up the air. A new rule was made. It said that n\_\_\_88\_\_ was allowed to burn coal in any British city. Just a few years later, the air became much cleaner.

Now many Chinese cities meet the same kind of p\_\_89 \_\_ with air pollution that London met forty or fifty years ago. However, it is more d\_\_90 \_\_ for Chinese cities to solve it. First, more of the pollution comes from big factories than from coal that people use in their houses. If these factories are suddenly c\_\_91 \_\_, lots of people will lose their jobs. Second, cleaner fuels are quite expensive. However, the air in many cities is already s\_\_92 \_\_becoming cleaner, because the government and ordinary people are trying to make pollution less.

So Walter was able to join the skydiving school. He came to all the lessons and worked very hard, although the other students were much younger than him, mostly about 30. Soon it was time for him to make his first jump. Ron asked him if he was feeling OK. Walter replied that he had never felt better. However, he added that there was something he should have told Ron earlier. Ron asked what it was and Walter smiled. Then, just before he jumped, he told Ron that he wasn't 60. Ron asked how old Walter really was and Walter told him he was 75!

Walter's first jump from a plane was six years ago and yesterday he made his eighteenth jump. "I should have started skydiving a long time ago!" he said.

Walter has lots of other hobbies. He enjoys riding fast motorbikes and climbing mountains. Last year he was saved by a police helicopter in Wales.

Walter's daughter Betty worries about him. "I think he should stop all these activities. But
